Pandit Arun Kashalkar is one of contemporary India's most innovative and complete Hindustani Classical Music Vocalists, a performer, deep thinker, prolific composer, and guru, scholar, and organizer with a radically new conception of the khayal form.

Pandit Arun Kashalkar's overwhelming importance in Hindustani music today lies in his many fundamental innovations to the khayal form, which have both deepened and widened its scope in several ways. India has many wonderful khayal singers, but Pandit Kashalkar's landmark contribution to this centuries-old genre lies in a rare and profound new vision, which has expanded the shape of khayal and infused it with a fresh sound.

Pandit Arun Kashalkar has been so deeply immersed in music that he has had neither the time nor the instinct to promote himself. His varied achievements are remarkable in themselves, but all the more so when one takes into account the fact that he was forced to hold down a day job for the first three decades after arriving in Mumbai in his early 20s, and has accomplished what he has in the field of music with little institutional support.

Sabina's remarkable musical journey was set off by her father Late Janab Nurul Islam. In the year 1988, she became 'Sangeet Visharad' from Bhatkhande Sangeet Vidyapeeth.

Sabina joined ITC Sangeet Research Academy, Kolkata in 1997 where she was trained in classical music by Janab Jainul Abedin and then under Late Pandit Sunil Bose - an exponent of Agra Gharana. She later came under the tutelage of Vidushi Shubra Guha, one of the doyens of the same Gharana, acquiring the prestigious scholarship in 1999. As a scholar of ITC Sangeet Research Academy, she has undergone rigorous training from her guru in the famous guru-shishya tradition and for the last 25 years continues to do so. She is permitted to give guidance in the absence of her Guru in the Academy. At the same time, she also adheres to the astute guidelines from her Guru Padmashree Pandit Vijay Kumar Kichlu, one of the great musicologists/exponents of Agra Gharana.

Satanik Chatterjee is a Classical Vocalist who belongs to a musical family and is a student of the Agra Gharana. He started training at the age of 6 from his mother Mrs. Gopa Chatterjee. After that, he started training under his first Guru Shri. Sanjib Mukherjee from the age of 7 only. After 11 years of long training from his first guru, Satanik moved on to take training from his bade guru, Ustad Waseem Ahmed Khan, a renowned classical vocalist of the Agra Gharana and continues his taalim. Satanik was also a Junior Musician Scholar at the ITC SANGEET RESEARCH ACADEMY under his Guruji Ustad Waseem Ahmed Khan. Apart from this he is still taking Tabla taalim and sangat training from his father Shri. Siddhartha Chatterjee.



ACHIEVEMENTS

In 2018, Satanik won the gold medal in the West Bengal State Youth Festival by standing first in classical vocal.

Also in this year he was nominated as a Classical Musician of Yuvvani Department at ALL INDIA RADIO, KOLKATA and he is a regular artist of AIR Kolkata.

In 2019, Satanik was adjudged the overall winner of the music competition organized by The Doverlane Music Conference and The Doverlane Music Academy, winning first place in Khayal, first place in Ragapradhan and second place in Bhajan.

Then in 2021, he won the first prize in Khayal Sangeet, first prize in Ragapradhan, second prize in Nazrul Geeti and third prize in Bhajan in the competition organized by Chetla Murari Smriti Sangeet Sammelani.

In 2022 Satanik has awarded with the National Scholarship approved by the Government of India which is awarded by the Ministry of Culture.

Also in 2022 Satanik has achieved the first position in Sri Bhaini Sahib Sangeet Sammelan adjudged by Pandit Ajay Chakroborty.

He is the grandson of "Sitar Ratna" Rahimat Khan, a Legendary Beenkar and Sitar player who was a disciple of renowned Ustad Bande Ali Khan. He had the fortune of long and traditional grooming from a young age from his father Prof. Abdul Karim Khan who was Head of the Faculty of Instrumental Music in the Karnataka University College of Music, Dharwad. He also received valuable guidance from his uncle Ustad Dastgir Khan and elder brothers Ustad Usman Khan and Late Ustad Bale Khan all well-known sitar players.



ACHIEVEMENTS

He has been conferred with the 'SURMANI' award by Sur Singar Samsad (Mumbai). Kala Vikas Parishad has honored him by conferring Bharath Ratna Pt. Bhimsen Joshi National Award - 2016. His musical sojourn took him to Germany and the United States in 2015 and his concerts there have been well-received. Sitar Jugalbandi's performances with his twin brother Rafique Khan have won encomia from media connoisseurs and music lovers. He has served as a member of the Karnataka Sangeet Nritya Academy. Born into a family steeped in music, Mahendra was initiated to the art by his father, Shri. Devidas Toke, who himself was deeply influenced by Ustad Amir Khan. When Khansaheb passed away Mahendra was still an infant. Thus he had no direct exposure to his muse. Hence it is remarkable that he has gone beyond mere imitation to imbibe the sonorous, contemplative quality, the subtle architectonics of sur and laya, the sense of poetic finesse, which are the essence of the Late Ustad's gayaki.



ACHIEVEMENTS

The call to music was so compelling that in 1988 Mahendra abandoned his studies in Electronics Engineering to devote himself totally to music. Recognition had already come when, in 1985, he won the Gold Medal at All India Radio's annual music contest in Pune. More honors were to follow. In 1986 he won the Gaan Heera Puraskar, named after the Kirana doyen Hirabai Badodekar. Sulashree Pratishtan, Pune, awarded him a three-year scholarship (1986-88) to pursue Hindustani Classical Music. In 1987 he received the Late Yeshwantraji Purohit Award from the Vile Parle Music Circle, Mumbai. In 1989 the Maharshi Gandharva Vedvishwa Vidyapeeth, New Delhi, awarded him a gold medal.

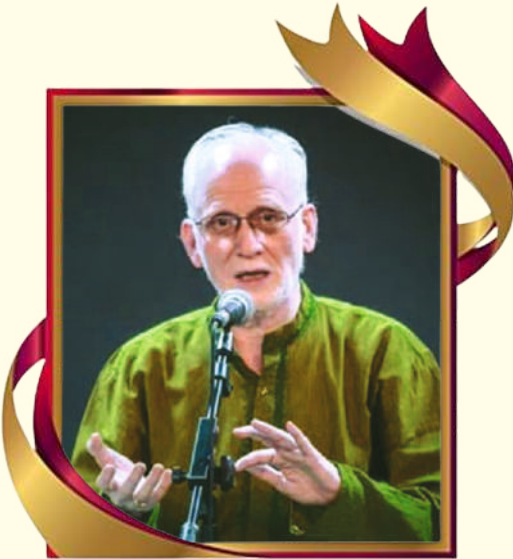
MUSIC CAREER

Pandit Shripad Hegde Kampli (born on 1st January 1957) who hails from Uttar Kannada district has been on the staff of AIR, Dharwad since 1987. Born in a family with a background of Yakshagana tradition, Pt. Shripad Hegde was attracted to music at a young age. He started his initial training in Hindustani music in his teen under Pandit Ganpati Bhat a notable student of Padma Vibhushan Pandit Basavaraj Rajguru. In the year 1982 Pt. Shripad Hegde moved to Dharwad to devote himself fully to Pt. Basavaraj Rajguru a stalwart doyen of Kirana Gharana who taught Shripad Hegde with love and affection. It was a decade-long dedicated and rigorous training under Pt. Basavaraj Rajguru who chiseled and shaped Pt. Shripad Hegde into a promising vocalist.

Pt Shripad Hegde has given spell bounded performances in prestigious stages like Alladiya Khan Punyatithi Samaroh Mumbai, Karnataka Sangha Mumbai, Deenanath Mangeshkar Punyatithi Goa, Mogubai Kurdikar Pune, Savai Gandharva Punyatithi Kundagol, Rehmat Khan Punyatithi Dharwad, Hampi Utsav, Dasara Festival Mysore, etc to name a few. Pandit Arun Kashalkar began learning from the age of five from his father in Pandharkowda, Yavatmal District in Eastern Maharashtra. At the age of 16, he enrolled for a BA in music in Yavatmal town, training under D V Panke, a student of the great Gwalior Gharana Maestro Krishnarao Shankar Pandit. At the age of 19, he moved to Nagpur to work in the AIR Office while training under Rajabhau Kokje, another Gwalior Gharana vocalist and thumri specialist. At the age of 23 Kashalkar moved to Mumbai to learn from Gajananbuva Joshi, training under him for eight years. Joshi had himself trained with leading masters of the Agra, Gwalior and Jaipur Gharanas. Kashalkar then trained under Ram Marathe for two years, followed by a decade-long stint with Babanrao Haldankar, who in turn, learned from greats of the Agra and Jaipur Gharana's Nivruttibuva Sarnaik, who knew him well: the Agra Gharana's Vilayat Hussain Khan, whose compositions and aesthetics he analyzed for his Ph.D.: and the Rampur Sahaswan Gharana's Nissar Hussain Khan.
